Play along with ramen and more

food wong ah yoke recommends

Ramen Play is launching its new menu this month with a host of new items to complement its ramen dishes. Those to try include a refreshing lobster salad (\$6.80, right) and the nabemushi tofu (\$6.80), a beancurd custard that is set in an earthen pot at the table, and butariki ishinabe (\$12.80), a stone pot rice with pan-fried and barbecued pork, onion, chives, seaweed and a raw egg. The new ramen items are improved on the previous recipes, too, especially the toriniku double soup ramen (\$16), which boasts a robust broth that blends shoyu and tonkotsu. Toppings include three types of pork: braised pork cheek, char shu and braised pork belly.
